17/105 Public Participation

Birches Nook Cottages

Ms Hawes said that staff from Northumberland County Council (NCC) and Northumbrian Water had not attended the planned meeting on 11 September 2017. After discussion Ms Hawes agreed to provide Mrs Dale with a few dates in March 2018 so that a further site meeting can be arranged. Ms Hawes will update the Council in due course.

Bus shelter Branch End

Mr Liddle has been approached by a resident who said that elderly and/or disabled users of the shelter are unable to see approaching buses whilst sitting on the bench in the shelter. The Clerk was asked to look at the issue.

Community Transport

Dr Vickers updated members on a visit he had made to Bell View Care at Belford with board members of Stocksfield Community Association. Amongst other things Bell View Care provides community transport for local residents.

17/111 Advisory Groups

a) General Governance Advisory Group (GGAG)

i) Notes of GGAG meeting 18/09/17

Members noted the previously circulated notes.

ii) Sports Field overspill car park - Public Works Loan Board

The Chair referred to a previously circulated report by the Clerk and the guidance documents from the Department for Communities and Local Government. Members noted that the estimated costs of the project are in the region of £50,000 but the final costs are not yet known. After discussion, it was AGREED (proposed Mr Parke, seconded Mrs Furniss) to seek the Secretary of State's approval to borrow £60,000 repayable over 20 years, recognising that although the Council has yet to set its budget and precept for 2018/19, the repayments for any such loan can be made without an increase in the precept from the current financial year.

iii) Dogs on Sports Fields: Public Space Protection Orders (PSPO)

Members considered a previously circulated report outlining the legal advice from the National Association of Local Councils and after discussion it was AGREED to ask NCC to reconsider their decision not to impose a PSPO banning dogs from the sports fields, on the grounds that this area is a de facto playing field for Broomley First School and is therefore a special case, given the fact that NCC has a duty of care to pupils at the school; to include further reference in this request to the Colchester PSPO which creates a precedent. **Action: Clerk** *iv) Play Area Inspections 2017*

Members noted a previously circulated report from the Clerk which identified the remedial work undertaken or planned to address the matters raised in the most recent inspection by the Royal Society for the Prevention of Accidents as well as other ancillary matters.

v) Sports Field User Group (SFUG)

Members noted the previously circulated notes of the meeting held on 31/07/17 and the Chair explained the relationship between the Parish Council, the Multi Use Games Area (MUGA) Committee and the SFUG. After discussion it was AGREED to amend the SFUG Terms of Reference to allow for a MUGA Committee meeting to take place within, but at the end of, SFUG meetings and to ask the Clerk to liaise with members of the MUGA Committee to propose amendments to its constitution which reflect working practices whilst retaining effective accountability.
